

## Baby, it's cold outside...



*These socks/slippers take care of warm feet inside when it's cold outside. Knit them first for yourself and then for your best friend, your husband, your children. They are made from leftovers, so use everything that looks nice to you. They are knit on needle 4 (Eur) / 6 USA – 4.5 (Eur) / 7 USA. I used fingering, dk, sport and worsted weight yarn, if necessary with double thread. Use the patterns below or go wild and find your own. Have fun!*

**Sizes:** 28-31/32-35/36-39/40-43 10-13/13-4/4.5-7.5/8-9.5

### **Materials:**

Leftovers for the leg; max 50 grams of sport weight for the foot  
needles 4/6 – 4.5/7

Soles (you can find them at [Wolhalla](http://Wolhalla), who will send them all over the world, or in your LYS)

### **Used patterns:**

#### **Rib:**

1 k, 1 p to end of row

#### **Stockinette**

Just knit all rows all the way.

#### **Garter rows:**

In 3 rows: knit one row, then purl two rows

## Nell-pattern (from the Nellpattern by Janneke

### Maat):

#### Round 1:

\*k tbl1, p1, k tbl1, yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k tbl1, p1, k tbl1, p1\*

Repeat \*this pattern\* over all stitches.

#### Round 2:

\*k tbl1, p1, k tbl1, k3, k tbl1, p1, k tbl1, p1\*

Repeat \*this pattern\* over all stitches.

### Square pattern

K 4 , P 4 – finish with 4 K

P 4 , K 4 – finish with 4 P

K 4 , P 4 – finish with 4 K

### Moss stitch

1K, 1 P to end of row

1P, 1 K to end of row

### INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 44/48/52 stitches on larger needles 4,5 / 6 (USA)

Knit rib 10 cm / 4 inch = 30 rows

Knit patterns for about 21 cm / 9 inch



Colour 1: Garter rows twice

Colour 2: Garter rows twice

Colour 3: 1 x Garter

Colour 4: 1 x Garter

Colour 3: 1 x Garter

Colour 5: 8 rows stockinette

1 x ktbl. r, 1<sup>e</sup> row Nell, 1 ktbl

1 x ktbl r, 2<sup>e</sup> row Nell, 1 ktbl

3 rows stockinette

Kleur 6: 1 x Garter

Kleur 7: 1 x Garter

4 x : 4 r en 4 a eindigen 4 k

Colour 8 4 x 4 k 4 p ending 4 p

3 x 4 p 4 a ending 4 k

Colour 3: 1 x Garter

**Totally 60 rows**

**Smaller needles (4/6), main colour**

Knit 3 rows

Next row: knit 9/10/11 st – k2tog : 4 x = 40/ 40/44/48 stitches. Arrange these stitches on three needles so that the centre of the heel is on the middle of needle 1, and the centre of the front is in between needles 2 and 3.

Knit.



Last stitch of second needle and first stitch of 3rd needle form the centre of the front. .

Next 15/17/18/20 rows M1 before the last stitch of the 2nd needle and M1 after the 1st st of the 3rd needle.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> needle: M1 by lifting the loop from the back to the front with your right needle, put it back on left needle – ktbl this new stitch
- 3<sup>rd</sup> needle: M1 by lifting the loop from the front to the back with your right needle and put it back on the left needle – ktbl this new stitch.

After 15/17/18/20 rows stockinette = about 5,5/6/6,5/7 cm or 2/2.5/2.8/3 inches you have 70/74/80/88 stitches. Arrange them over four needles. Now continue for the sole: 15/15/17/17 rows in garter ending with a purl row. Put the stitches of needle 1 and 2 on one needle and those of 3 and 4 on one needle. Close with kitchener stitch.

Make the sock to the sole and knit the other one. Same or totally different. Have warm feet all day long.
